As part of this exciting topic, we'll also help the children discover their own superpowers — focusing on how they can be helpful, kind, and thoughtful. Whether it's sharing, helping a friend, or simply being a good listener, every child can be a superhero in their own way.

Through stories, role play and creative activities, we'll be celebrating the special people, animals, and even superhero vehicles that make our lives brighter and better. Together, we'll explore what it means to be unique, and how we can all help those around us — because there's a little hero in everyone! We will begin by exploring the stories Superhero Mum and Superhero Dad by Timothy Knapman. These engaging books will help us celebrate the special people who care for us and introduce exciting learning opportunities across all areas of the Early Years curriculum.

Children will:
